Requirements: The recipient of this scholarship must be enrolled in a public works related program at an accredited South Carolina private or public college or university, maintain a B (3.0) grade average, be from one of the counties in the Upstate Branch area (Abbeville, Anderson, Cherokee, Chester, Greenville, Greenwood, Lancaster, Laurens, McCormick, Oconee, Pickens, Spartanburg, Union or York) and submit an essay about why they are interested in public works and how their major relates to public works.
